

IN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, LANE COUNTY OREGON

ORDER 95-7-5-1) IN THE MATTER OF PROVIDING \$2,000 OF VIDEO LOTTERY FUNDS TO THE ANIMAL DAMAGE PROGRAM FOR INCREASED COUGAR CONTROL.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is one of three funding sources that interdependently fund the Animal Damage Program, and

WHEREAS, there has been an increase in the incidents of Cougar damage to property and people in the past year in Lane County, and

WHEREAS, the Rural Community Improvement Council recommends the expenditure of \$2,000 in video lottery funds from the special projects category to increase staffing of the Animal Damage Program to deal with this problem, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY:

ORDERED that \$ 2,000 of the RCIC FY94/95 project carryforward be granted to the Animal Damage Program for increased Cougar control in rural Lane County and be transferred from Operational Contingency to Materials and Services - General Expense (17) and within the Economic Development Program (080) in the Special Revenue/Services Fund (Fund 28).
