ORDER) In the Matter of Committing Property Management Funds to
95-7-5-8) Assist in a Solution to the City of Westfir's Water Intake
) Facility Emergency

Whereas, the City of Westfir takes its water for drinking water purposes from the North Fork of the Middle Fork of the Willamette River, in Lane County, and

Whereas, the intake pipe for the City water supply is dangerously close to losing sufficient and constant immersion in the river, such that the City may at any time be without water for the community of Westfir, and

Whereas, the river course, depth, and channeling is changing and this may be due in part to removal of the Westfir Mill Dam about one year ago because it posed a danger to downstream structures, and subsequently adversely impacted fish habitat, and

Whereas, Lane County, as the foreclosure property owner of the Westfir Mill Site, participated in the process of dam removal, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

1) ORDERED that up to \$5,000 from the Tax Foreclosed Property Sales program in the Department of Human Resources and Management Services, within the Special Revenue Fund (28), is authorized to design and construct emergency water source facilities in the City of Westfir.

2) FURTHER ORDERED that Lane County shall request the assistance of state and federal agencies to expedite any required permits to avert a water shortage for the City of Westfir.
