RESOLUTION AND ORDER NO. 95-9-20-3

(IN THE MATTER OF IMPROVING CENTENNIAL
BOULEVARD FROM I-5 TO PRESCOTT LANE
(AND ASPEN STREET FROM CENTENNIAL
BOULEVARD TO CENTENNIAL ELEMENTARY
SCHOOL

WHEREAS, Centennial Boulevard from I-5 to Prescott Lane, Legal Road Number 1304, and Aspen Street from Centennial Boulevard to Centennial Elementary School are in need of improvements to provide for the safety of the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, Centennial Boulevard and Aspen Street are within the urban area and curbs gutters and sidewalks are required in road reconstruction to bring the road into conformance with the requirements of Lane Code; and

WHEREAS, the improvements of Centennial Boulevard, including a portion of Aspen Street, have been scheduled in the 1996-2000 Capital Improvement Program, adopted May 3, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Order Numbered 95-4-19-14, approving the project design for Centennial Boulevard and Aspen Street, as recommended by the Roads Advisory Committee, and ordered that staff prepare a right of way plan necessary to construct the project, pursue all necessary planning actions, acquire right of way and prepare plans and specifications for the improvement of Centennial Boulevard and Aspen Street; and

WHEREAS, County staff was authorized by Board Order No. 94-9-27-3 to prepare an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Springfield and the Common Council of said City has approved, by Resolution No. 95-28, the assessment of effected property within said City by Lane County in accordance with the policies of Lane County and said Intergovernmental Agreement has been executed on June 7, 1995: NOW

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the cost of the improvements be assessed to the benefiting property owners as follows: the costs incurred for the construction of curbs, gutters, and sidewalks shall be assessed on a cost per front foot basis to the properties abutting said improvements in the following manner; sidewalks by the square yard excluding driveway sections, driveways by the square yard, curbs and gutters by the lineal foot, plus 15% for engineering and administrative costs.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Director of the Public Works Department investigate the proposed improvements and present a report to the Board of County Commissioners as specified in ORS 371.625.
