WHEREAS, the establishment of the United States Basketball Academy has been determined to be beneficial to the economy of the Upper McKenzie River region; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that the expenditure of Lane County road funds on public roads for economic development purposes is an appropriate act;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$100,000 of Lane County road funds is authorized for construction of a public road to serve the United States Basketball Academy and;

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER:

ORDERED that the County Administrator will determine an expeditious way to have said public road constructed.
