WHEREAS, the use of tobacco is an unhealthy and potentially deadly choice for the youth of our community; and

WHEREAS, it is illegal in the state of Oregon for youth under the age of 18 to use or purchase tobacco products in any form and it is also illegal for anyone to provide or sell tobacco products to anyone under the age of 18; now therefore it is,

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners encourage the merchants selling tobacco in our community to display signs detailing the legal age of purchase and to always ask for the identification of every young person attempting to buy tobacco who looks age 26 or younger; and further

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners supports the Eugene Community Partnership For Tobacco-Free Kids Campaign, and by this effort hopes to join other communities who have lowered the number of youth addicted to nicotine by limiting their ability to purchase tobacco.
