WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has currently and in past years accepted revenues pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement #20-001 with the State Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Services Division; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement provides for a community mental health program to support services to individuals with developmental disabilities, mental/emotional disturbances and alcohol/drug problems; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Services Division has forwarded the 1997-99 Intergovernmental Agreement #20-001; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement details roles and responsibilities of the County and the Division as well as definitions and funding limitations for services; and

WHEREAS, Lane County staff have reviewed the document and recommend acceptance; and

WHEREAS, a competitive process was conducted per Lane Manual 21.110 and providers were selected to implement the services detailed in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, contracts for these services may be awarded, "contingent upon available funding," as soon as possible to allow time for processing prior to the July 1, 1997 begin date; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners shall award contracts per Lane Manual 21.120; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners may delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the agreement and subsequent subcontracts; now therefore it is hereby



ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign for concurrence with the 1997-99 Intergovernmental Agreement #20-001; and further

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the subcontracts as detailed in Exhibit A.
