)BIDS AND AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR

WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on June 24, 1997, Craig Satein of the Housing Authority and Community Services Agency of Lane County, Oregon, opened bids on the following projects:

Furnishing all labor and most materials to perform the Weatherization of Homes, Phases 97W-0047 and 97W-0048, in strict accordance with the project specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest responsible bidders for the work were Southtowne Glass at \$2,377 per home; and Lane County Glass, Inc. at \$2,578 per home; the Executive Director having so recommended;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Southtowne Glass be awarded a \$100,000 requirements contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project Phase 97W-0047 and that Lane County Glass Inc. be awarded a \$100,000 requirements contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project Phase 97W-0048, and that agreements be executed by the Executive Director in accordance with the bid documents. The contractors shall present a valid performance and payment bond for the full contract amount, and shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified contract time.


