ORDER 97-9-10-2 \_\_\_\_\_ IN THE MATTER OF ISSUING A LETTER OF  
SUPPORT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE  
JUVENILE JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM  
(JJIS).

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature has mandated the creation of a statewide juvenile justice information system and provided funding for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, Lane County supports the creation of a statewide system; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature has delegated allocation of funds for system development to the Emergency Board; and

WHEREAS, letters of support from the Oregon counties are needed to demonstrate readiness to proceed; and

WHEREAS, readiness to proceed is essential to allocation of funds from the Emergency Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the Chair of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign the proposed letter of support.

This letter is written to affirm support for the Juvenile Justice Information System (JJIS) project. Lane County understands the critical need for state-wide juvenile justice data and we intend to incorporate the JJIS into the operation of our juvenile department.

We understand the State of Oregon will provide development, support and maintenance of the JJIS software. Additionally the State of Oregon will provide the wide area network telecommunications connection needed by each county. The County acknowledges that a minimum standard of hardware and software will be required to operate the JJIS and we acknowledge that we will be responsible for any costs associated with upgrading of county computer systems that may be necessary to incorporate JJIS into our operation and any non-JJIS specific training that may be required.

We acknowledge the potential benefits of the JJIS to the people of our county and to the State of Oregon. Subject to budget realities, Lane County intends to integrate the JJIS into the operation of our juvenile department. We encourage the State support necessary to make this system a reality and we pledge continued involvement with the Steering Committee as this system is developed and implemented.
