WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on October 14,
1999, Ed Quigley, Weatherization Energy Auditor of the Housing
Authority and Community Services Agency of Lane County, opened bids
on the following project:

Pressure Diagnostics and Duct Sealing,
Weatherization of Homes Project 00-R-0011, in
strict accordance with the project
specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent low responsible bid for the work was
\$301.50 per home submitted by Delta-T; and the Executive Director
having so recommended, IT IS HEREBY


ORDERED, that Delta-T- be awarded a contract for performing
pressure diagnostics and sealing residential HVAC systems,
Weatherization of Homes Project 00-R-0011 for a total cost not to
exceed \$40,000, and that an agreement be executed by the Executive
Director in accordance with the bid documents. The Contractor
shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified
contract time.
