WHEREAS, the Lane County Board of Commissioners, sitting as a local contract review board, has adopted public contracting rules as set forth in Lane Manual Chapters 20 and 21;

WHEREAS, this new law requires public contracting agencies who wish to apply their own public contracting rules to expressly opt out of the Attorney General's model rules as modified;

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's model rules effective in October 1999, have been reviewed;

NOW, THEREFORE, sitting as the local contract review board, the Board hereby ORDERS that:

1. The Attorney General's model public contracting rules (OAR Ch. 137) as modified and effective in October, 1999 in accordance with 1999 Oregon Laws, Chapter 29, Section 1, do not apply to Lane County and its public contracts; and
2. Lane County expressly establishes the adoption of and reaffirms the applicability of the rules of procedure for public contracts set forth in Lane Manual Chapters 20 and 21; and
3. Within Lane Manual Chapters 20 and 21, any references to adoption of specific AG model rules do not refer to those as modified in the October 1999 version, rather to the preceding version(s) of those specific rules.
