WHEREAS, the Jordan Pit, formerly owned by Lane County and now owned by the Eugene Water & Electric Board (EWEB), is the location of a substantial stockpile of old, scrap tires, and

WHEREAS, some of the old tires on the Jordan Pit site were apparently placed there by Lane County in anticipation of funding for a road construction research project involving use of shredded tires in a road base, and

WHEREAS, EWEB would now like to remove the old tires from Jordan Pit, and

WHEREAS, EWEB has requested that Lane County share equally with it in a tire cleanup project involving funding by Lane County, EWEB and DEQ, and

WHEREAS, the Road Fund cannot be used directly in the tire cleanup effort following changes to the Oregon Constitution limiting use of gas tax revenues even though any tires placed on the Jordan Pit site by Lane County were apparently placed there in anticipation of use in a road construction project that was never realized, and

WHEREAS, the City of Eugene has indicated that they have an ability to accept a payment from the County Road Fund to be used for legal road purposes while freeing up general City funding for a payment to EWEB for the tire cleanup project, **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY**

**ORDERED** that a \$45,000 Budget Transfer from Operational Contingency to Payments to Agencies in the Road Fund Budget is approved, **AND BE IT HEREBY FURTHER**

**ORDERED** that funding is authorized for a payment of up to \$45,000 from the County Road Fund to the City of Eugene to be used for legal road purposes in order to free up general City funding for a payment to EWEB for a tire cleanup project at EWEB's Jordan Pit property.
