WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office Road Crew program has an excess number of inmates serving Short term sentences to supervise, and

WHEREAS, the City of Eugene has insufficient jail bed space for municipal offenders, and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Jail has continuing overcrowding conditions, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office Population Management Team and the Sheriff's Road Crew program have established policies, procedures and resource to select and provide City of Eugene municipal offenders to a supervision resource, and


WHEREAS, the City of Eugene desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement paying for supervision resource, as well as necessary material and services, and


WHEREAS, City of Eugene and Sheriff's representatives have previously entered into a similar agreement, and

WHEREAS, because of the effectiveness of the Sheriff's road crew program in providing alternative custody and service tot he community, and

WHEREAS, the City of Eugene seeks to expand it's sanctioning options to hold offenders accountable, and

HEREBY, ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate the authority to the Sheriff and the County Administrator to sign the intergovernmental agreement between the City of Eugene and the Lane County Sheriff's Office.
