ORDER NO. 99-08-04- 8 IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH LANE COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT DATE AND ADD ADDITIONAL SERVICES FOR \$35,000 IN SUPPORT OF THE AREA INFORMATION RECORDS SYSTEM

WHEREAS, The Regional Executive Group (REG) has approved a technical strategy for the AIRS conversion based on recommendations from an AIRS Technology Group and on a study done by Deloitte and Touche, and

WHEREAS, the recommendation includes completion of law enforcement and CAD business analyses and the full requirements analysis as early prerequisite tasks to any AIRS procurement, and

WHEREAS, LCOG has a qualified resource to perform these analyses, whose cost will be covered by grant funding, it is hereby

ORDERED that an amendment to the existing Intergovernmental Agreement with LCOG for law enforcement and CAD analyses to add \$35,000 and extend the agreement date to September 30, 1999, is approved; and that the County Administrator be authorized to sign the amendment.
