WHEREAS, Lane County is committed to preventing the use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use by its youths; and

WHEREAS, Oregon's High-Risk Juvenile Crime Prevention Partnership/State Incentive Cooperative Agreement is an intergovernmental agreement which forwards \$55,250 to reduce the use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs by youth; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year of this three year federal grant; and

WHEREAS, during the 1998-99 fiscal year the Public Safety Coordinating Council coordinated a planning process funded by this grant (board order #98-6-24-34) which resulted in the designation of funds to support a full-time coordinator of substance abuse prevention efforts in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services coordinated a planning process which resulted in an implementation plan that designated \$10,000 for the support of such a position and the funds have been appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Children and Families also designated \$5,250 to be used to support such a position and those funds must be appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the sum of the funds, \$65,250 will support a full-time program services coordinator position; and

WHEREAS, Lane County must use the revenues in the intergovernmental agreement through its administrative agent the Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS, the total, \$55,250, in the intergovernmental agreement exceeds the signature authority of the county administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners as the governing body of Lane County may, in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 294.326(2), appropriate by resolution, unanticipated revenues and expenditures; now therefore it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners accept Oregon's High-Risk Juvenile Crime Prevention Partnership/State Incentive Cooperative Agreement in the amount of \$55,250; and

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the county administrator to sign for acceptance of the document; and

ORDERED, that a permanent full-time program services coordinator position be established in the Department of Health and Human Services (34); and further

RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners increase the fiscal year 1999-2000 appropriations in revenues and expenditures for the Department of Health and Human Services (34) by the appropriation of \$55,250 in revenues and expenditures in Fund 286.
