WHEREAS, the City of Eugene and Lane County have entered into intergovernmental agreements dealing with urban transition since adoption of the Eugene Metro Plan; and

WHEREAS, the River Road and Santa Clara areas contain the largest unincorporated lands and existing developments within the Eugene portion of the urban growth boundary; and


WHEREAS, Lane County recognizes that urban services will eventually be provided, including sanitary sewers, water, fire, police, parks and recreation, electrical service, land use controls, storm drainage, street lighting and libraries; and

WHEREAS, Lane County desires to participate in resolving the service needs of the unincorporated areas within the urban growth boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Eugene Metro Plan calls for eliminating unnecessary special service districts and revising confusing or illogical service boundaries, including those that cause redundant effort or overlapping service; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to work with citizens and the other jurisdictions within the urban growth boundary to effectively provide urban services in an efficient manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Lane County Board of Commissioners does hereby support the River Road and Santa Clara Areas Urban Services Study.
