)Division to Continue Survey and Preliminary
)Engineering Work Necessary to Refine
)Safety Improvement Options on Highway 126
)Associated With the Goodpasture Boat Landing

WHEREAS, through Order 00-05-10-2, the Board of County Commissioners authorized the Parks Division to pursue development of a boat landing in the vicinity of the Goodpasture Bridge, after obtaining assurances that traffic safety issues can be adequately addressed; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Division requested assistance from the Engineering Division in assessing traffic safety issues associated with the boat landing; and

WHEREAS, property owners refused entry to Engineering survey crews to collect topographic data necessary to design potential safety improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Division used ODOT data to prepare preliminary designs for three safety improvement options; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of these options is substantially higher than otherwise would be expected because of rock outcroppings along Highway 126 near the boat landing; and

WHEREAS, continued refinement of these options is impossible without complete survey data;
NOW THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED that the Engineering Division is directed to complete survey, engineering and appraisal work necessary to refine the design and cost estimates for safety improvement options at the Goodpasture boat landing; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Engineering Division is directed to work with ODOT to agree upon a cost-effective improvement to address safety concerns at the site.
