WHEREAS, the travel and tourism industry supports the vital interests of Lane County, Oregon, and the United States, contributing to our employment, economic prosperity, international trade and relations, peace, understanding, and goodwill; and

WHEREAS, travel and tourism rank as one of Lane County's and Oregon's largest industries in revenues generated; and

WHEREAS, travelers visiting Lane County contributed \$426.4 million to the economy in 1999; and

WHEREAS, those travelers provided jobs for 6,500 citizens in Lane County by generating a payroll of \$90.6 million; and

WHEREAS, as people throughout the world become more aware of the outstanding cultural and recreational resources available in Lane County and Oregon and the United States, travel and tourism will become an increasingly important aspect in the lives of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of these laudable contributions to the economic, social, and cultural well-being of the citizens of Lane County, it is fitting that we recognize the importance of travel and tourism; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Lane County Board of Commissioners that the week of May 7 through 13, 2000, is hereby designated Lane County Tourism Week, and the Commissioners are authorized and requested to issue a proclamation calling upon the people of Lane County to observe this week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
