ORDINANCE NO. 2-00) IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING CHAPTERS 2 AND 15
) OF LANE CODE TO REMOVE PROVISIONS PERTAINING
) TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
) REVOLVING LOAN FUND AND DISSOLVING THAT FUND
) (LC 2.500 AND 15.642)

WHEREAS, on April 16, 1997 the Board of County Commissioners established the Economic Development Assistance Program (EDAP) Revolving Loan Fund and provided assessment policies for EDAP improvements by Ordinance Numbers 4-97 and 5-97; and

WHEREAS, no applications for funding from the EDAP Revolving Loan Fund were made since establishment of the fund; and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing the Board has determined dissolution of the EDAP Revolving Loan Fund and distribution of the assets to the Lane County Road Fund for use in the Community Development Road Improvement Assistance Program is in the best interests of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

The EDAP Revolving Loan Fund is hereby dissolved and the assets of that fund shall be distributed to the Lane County Road Fund.

Chapters 2 and 15 of Lane Code are hereby amended by removing and substituting the following pages:





(3) By Petition or Resolution-Bridges. When the Board of County Commissioners determines the public interest requires improvement to bridges on a local access road, the direct cost of bridge improvement or replacement shall be assessed to the specially benefiting property owners on a uniform basis as determined by the Board.

15.640 Intersections. The cost of street improvements located within street intersections and railroad intersections shall be paid by Lane County on projects where there is joint participation in the improvement costs.

15.645 Foreclosure. The Director of the Department of Assessment and Taxation shall have the duties and responsibility of the County Court in ORS 371.650(3) and ORS 371.660 and shall have the general responsibility for record keeping and collection of ORS Chapter 371 assessments made under the authority of ORS Chapter 371 and this subchapter.
