WHEREAS, ORS 423.560 establishes Public Safety Coordinating Councils and mandates Councils develop and recommend to boards of county commissioners a comprehensive plan for the use of state resources to serve the local offender population;


WHEREAS, on November 10, 1999 the Lane County Board of Commissioners approved a Community Corrections Plan;

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2000 the Lane County Public Safety Coordinating Council made recommendations to be forwarded to the Board regarding changes to the Community Corrections Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following amendments be made to the FY 99-01 Community Corrections Plan:

1. the Community Corrections Plan money allocated to residential alcohol and drug treatment for FY 00-01 (\$156,127) be reallocated to the Lane County Sheriff's Office to help fund the Forest Work Camp; and
2. the Community Corrections Plan money allocated to employment assistance for FY 00-01 (\$27,550), FY 99-00 rollover (\$7,000), and unallocated money (\$13,620) be divided between Parole and Probation (\$39,420) and Transitional Housing (\$8,750).
