WHEREAS, on June 27, 2000, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Order No. 00-6-27-2 In the Matter of An Election Authorizing a Four Year Operating Local Option Tax and Adopting a Ballot Title, in which the Board referred a levy to the voters for the November, 2000 election to fund added operational capacity for the adult jail and juvenile corrections system, and

WHEREAS, since that time, the initiative Measure 93 has been also placed on the November ballot, and

WHEREAS, Measure 93, if adopted, would prohibit the collection of the taxes for the County operating levy unless it contains the words mandated by Measure 93, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Lane County that the Board revise the ballot title to remove any possible impediments to its effectiveness, should the voters choose to approve the levy,

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Exhibit A of Order No. 00-6-27-2 is hereby replaced with the attached Revised Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, there being no other changes to Order No. 00-6-27-2, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Senate Bill 1608 or similar federal legislation is enacted, the Board of County Commissioners will use a public process, including a public hearing, to determine the allocation of any unrestricted funds received under such federal legislation, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the explanatory statement committee address the requirements contained in Measure 93 in their statement regarding this ballot measure.



Revised Exhibit A

- Caption:** WORK CAMP, JAILS AND SERVICES FOUR-YEAR LOCAL OPTION TAX
- Question:** Shall Lane County levy \$0.5476 per \$1000 of assessed value for operations for four years starting 2001-2002? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.
- Summary:** A "yes" vote on this measure is a vote to increase taxes. The main purpose of this measure is to fund added capacity for the adult jail and juvenile corrections systems. It would fund operations of the Forest Work Camp to a full capacity of 120 beds. It would also increase staffing in the jail intake center. It would increase the beds used in the juvenile justice center from 36 to 64 to operate two full housing sections, as was intended when the center was designed. It would provide for running a juvenile assessment center to evaluate youth for mental health, substance abuse and risk to commit new crimes. It would add 7 beds at the Youth Campus drug and alcohol treatment center.

Another purpose of this measure is to maintain existing programs in the County general fund. The majority of available County general funds are used for the Sheriff, District Attorney and juvenile law enforcement programs and related expenses. General fund programs have been cut in 6 of the last 9 years.

It is estimated the proposed rate will raise \$9,655,195 in 2001-2002, \$9,852,186 in 2002-2003, \$10,112,207 in 2003-2004, and \$10,380,771 in 2004-2005, for a total of \$40,000,358.
