ORDINANCE NO. PA 1152) **IN THE MATTER OF NAMING A NEWLY**
) **CONSTRUCTED PRIVATE ROAD,**
) **WHITEWATER ROAD (17-15-17-4)**

WHEREAS, this matter now coming before the Board upon a petition received by the Surveyor's Office of the Lane County Department of Public Works requesting that a newly constructed private road, be named Whitewater Road; and

WHEREAS, said road begins about 400 feet southeast of the intersection of Deerhorn Road and Bridge Street at a point along the southerly right-of-way line of Bridge Street, and meanders in a southeasterly direction, approximately 1800 feet, to the centerline of Haagen Creek; and

WHEREAS, Lane County Surveyor's Office has received a valid application signed by a majority of the landowners whose property adjoins this private roadway, requesting that said roadway be named Whitewater Road; and

WHEREAS, approving the proposed name for this road will satisfy Condition of Approval No. 39 of Land Partition PA 99-5981; and

WHEREAS, the proposed name, Whitewater Road, meets all the criteria in Lane Manual 15.020; and

WHEREAS, authority was granted to Lane County by ORS Chapter 215, Lane Code Chapter 15 and the Lane County Home Rule Charter regarding procedures and requirements relating to the naming and renaming of roads in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, legal notice has been provided in accordance with Lane Manual 15.025; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2000, the Lane County Board of Commissioners conducted the First Reading of this Ordinance, and on August 30, 2000, conducted the Second Reading and held a public hearing to consider the road naming ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

1. That the private road as described above and shown on Attachment 'A', attached hereto and made a part hereof by this Ordinance, is hereby named Whitewater Road.
2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

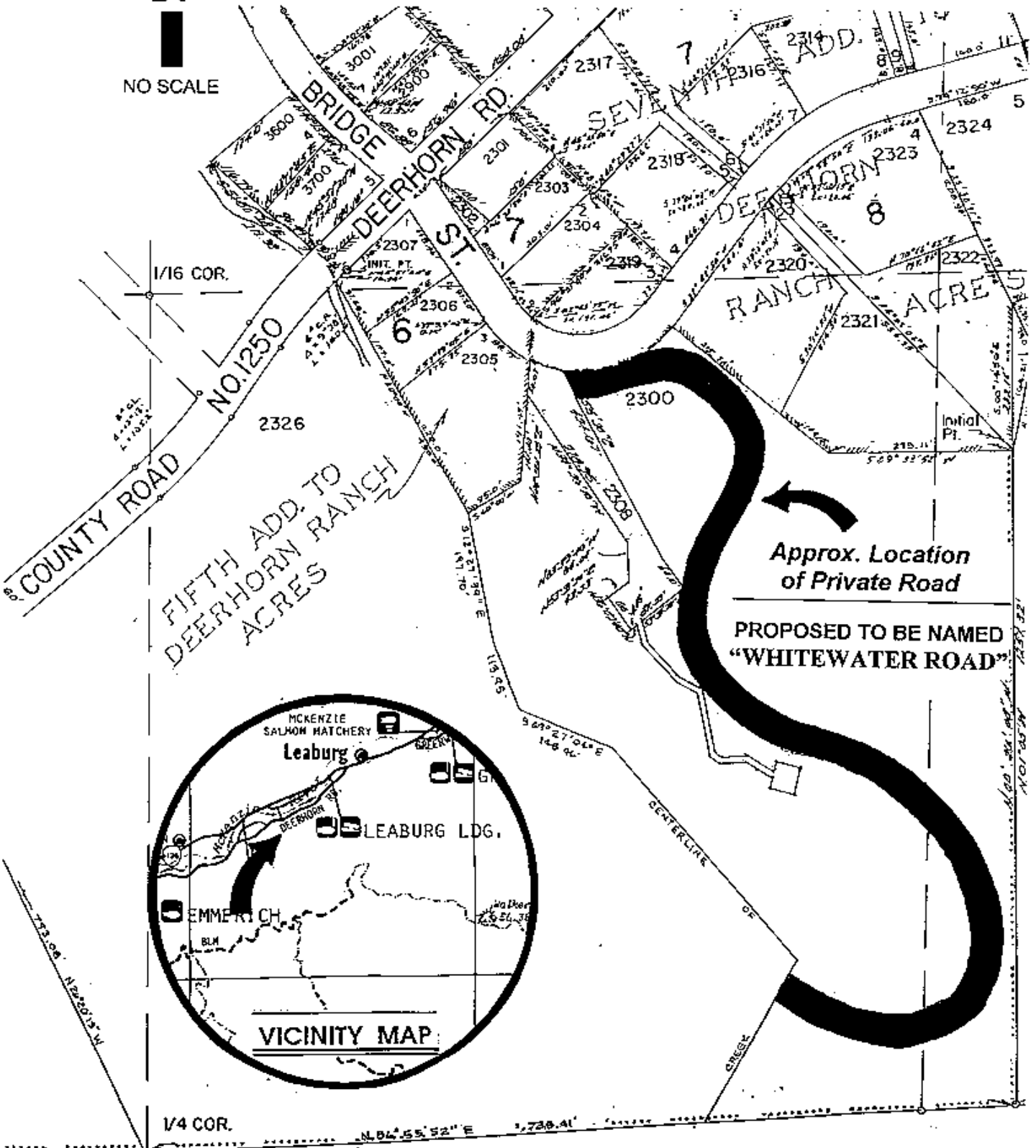

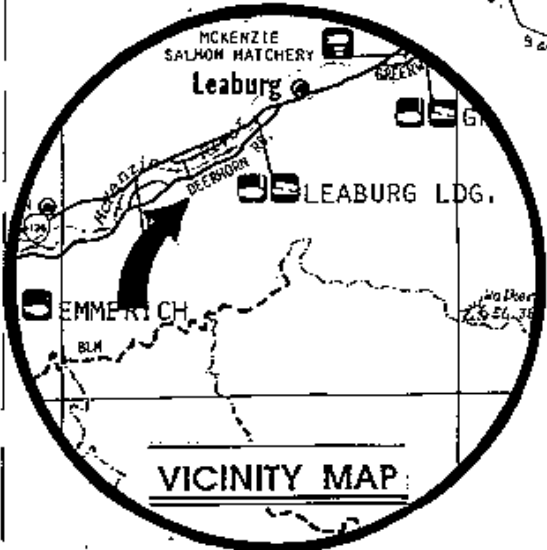


NO SCALE
