WHEREAS, the Crime Victim and Survivor Services program of the District Attorney's office provides services to crime victims not available from any other public agency or non-profit organization, and

WHEREAS, the Crime Victim and Survivor Services program will be able to increase and enhance existing services to crime victims through funding available from the Oregon Department of Justice, and

WHEREAS, the Crime Victim and Survivor Services program has written two successful grant applications to receive these funds,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


The Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Lane County, accept two grant awards from the Oregon Department of Justice, (one for \$35,172 & .25 FTE and one for \$43,909 & .75 FTE), appropriate a total of \$79,081 in revenue and expense authority for the District Attorney's budget in the General Fund, increase FTE in the District Attorney's office by 1.0 and delegate signature authority to the County Administrator to execute both grant award documents.
