Chair Bill Rogers presided with Steve Cornacchia, Jack Roberts and Jerry Rust present. Ellie Dumdi excused. Judy Haldeman, Recording Secretary.

1. ADJUSTMENTS TO THE AGENDA

Rogers announced that there will be an Executive Session following this meeting.

3. COMMISSIONERS' ANNOUNCEMENTS

Rust asked that there be some written findings from the Elections Division with regard to the errors in this election. Cornacchia suggested that there be a work session with Dave Spriggs and Jef Faw regarding dealing with the press. Roberts suggested that there be a written report first to determine the extent of the problem, suggest steps for mitigation and to explain what has been learned from these errors. Rogers agreed that a written response would be reasonable as a first step.

Rust thanked John Goodson, Director of Public Works, for his timely response on the industrial lands issue with the City of Eugene.

Roberts announced that he had received a call from Dumdi in Washington, DC, expressing her pleasure that the levy had passed.
