1. SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT/Board of Health.


Rob Rockstroh, Director of Health and Human Services, presented this item to the Board (see report on file). Rockstroh reported that there was a plan to combine seven state Department of Human Resources (DHR) agencies into three; insurance, case management and services. He said that this plan would significantly increase the bureaucracy at the state level, though it is intriguing as a model of case coordination and case management.

Rockstroh stated that the Intergovernmental Human Services Committee is working on a balance between the policy, planning and the providers in the community and a process which incorporates providers without giving undue influence to any of the parties.

Rockstroh reported that if a child is Medicaid eligible and has a problem, the County is obligated to find treatment for the child based on Early Periodic Screening Diagnosis and Treatment. This will push the system toward children and away from adults and cause a significant expansion of child services within the mental health system.

Rockstroh commented that one issue for his department is appropriate space which is designed for function. He reported that the B&H Stump Ranch is now called Ranch Care and is under new ownership and organization. Frazier asked Rockstroh to keep the Board informed on the Department of Human Resources and Dumdi asked to be kept up to date on Ranch Care.

There being no further business, this meeting adjourned at 9:17 a.m.
