Steve Cornacchia, Jack Roberts and Jerry Rust present. Ellie Dumdi and Marie Frazier absent. Jerry Pierce, Recording Secretary.


Commissioner Rust called the meeting to order. Staff indicated that an emergency meeting was necessary as 150 arraignments were awaiting action the following day and a Justice Pro Tempore was necessary to process them. Gabrielle Glenn from the Central Lane Justice Court was present and explained the need to appoint a Justice Pro Tempore to serve at certain times in July and August when Judge William Simons was not able to serve because of other obligations or potential conflicts of interest, and because of the resignation of Rob Laney.

Commissioner Roberts MOVED to appoint Herb Evans as Justice Pro Tempore to be assigned by Judge William Simons during any absence of Judge Simons from July 6, 1992 through August 22, 1992.

Commissioner Cornacchia expressed concern that the Board of Commissioners was appointing a person about whom they had no knowledge. The Board expressed a desire that Gabrielle Glenn make known to Judge Simons that they wanted a process in the future that included an opportunity for the Commissioners to receive information about the person or persons they were asked to consider for appointment, and that the information should include verification that the minimum requirements for qualification were met.

Motion SECONDED by Commissioner Cornacchia. VOTE: 3-0.

There being no further business, this meeting adjourned at 2:12 p.m.
