2. REPORT/Semi-Annual Board of Health Report.

Rob Rockstroh, Director of Health and Human Services, presented this item to the Board. He reported that there may be some funding available for beds for child psychiatric care at Sacred Heart. He commented that there was an interfaith newsletter being circulated as a budget alert which states that if the levy fails the \$200,000 allocation would be cut from the budget; the \$200,000 is part of the base budget and will most likely not be cut. He highlighted the department's work in prevention of child abuse and in maternal/child health and stated that he had received \$1.2 million in children's medicare funds for mental health. He reported that some work had been done on specialized housing for developmentally disabled mothers with help from Marie Bell. Dumdi commented that she was interested in viewing a family planning video which had been prepared by Sheldon High School students. The Board agreed that it would be helpful to view this video. Rust encouraged more visibility for the public health agency and its contribution to Lane County.

There being no further business, this meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
