The meeting convened at 1:30 p.m. Chair Steve Cornacchia presided with Marie Frazier, Jack Roberts, Jerry Rust and Ellie Dumdi present. Jane Burgess and Beth McAllister Recording Secretaries.

1. PUBLIC HEARING/Mass Gathering Permit for Tribal Outreach, May 14, 15 and 16, 1993.

Cornacchia announced the cancellation of the public hearing. Bill VanVector, Acting County Administrator, explained that the public hearing had been canceled due to a request from the organizers of the event. He stated that the event had been postponed because of the wetness of the site.

Joe Schmerber, co-director for the Tribal Outreach, restated the event was being postponed because of the condition of the site. Based upon other events scheduled in the area, they are hoping to reschedule their event for the first week of July. Cornacchia said that the conditions of the permit would change from May to July because of the dates, fire concerns, and tourism travel. He further requested that the second week of July be considered as to not conflict with July 4 events already scheduled.

Mr. Schmerber agreed to consider the end of July as well as the beginning of August. He stated their intent is not to conflict with other events previously planned.

Stan Petrsek, Environmental Health, informed the Board of the conditions of the transportation plan which ultimately would need approval from the Sheriff's office. Mr. Schmerber said the plan would be available prior to the public hearing. Mr. Petrsek explained that the fire plan would need to be approved by the fire chief. Cornacchia requested that all information be available on the day of the public hearing so the Board would be prepared to make a decision.

Frazier questioned the requirements regarding noise levels. Cornacchia answered that the current County noise ordinance would remain in effect.


