10. EMERGENCY BUSINESS

ORDER 93-3-30-3 In the Matter of Imposing a Temporary Weight Limitation on the Goodpasture Covered Bridge (165-2E-29)

Ollie Snowden, County Engineer, stated that OBEC had inspected the bridge and found some rotting. He recommended that a weight limitation be put on the bridge as no one is hauling at this time. He will have the hauling monitored. He advocated the repair of the stringers in June.

MOTION: Approval. Rust MOVED, Frazier SECONDED. VOTE: 5-0.

9. PUBLIC WORKS

a. DISCUSSION AND ACTION/Selection of a Preferred Improvement Alternative for the Bridge Street Bridge

Marie Frazier, Commissioner representing the area recommended an extensive rehabilitation of the bridge. Jerry Rust concurred with Frazier's recommendation which is a practical choice and also popular with the people of that area. Steve Cornacchia stated that in viewing the intersection at Holden Creek Road he remains unconvinced that this work needs to be done in widening the intersection. He has not seen any problems during a heavily travelled time. People just need to be more aware and take more care when driving through this intersection

After discussion, the Board directed that extensive rehabilitation of the bridge should occur, with a right turn lane and realignment of road on hold for a future date.

Snowden stated that next summer is the most likely time to schedule the rehabilitation work. Some remedial work will be done this summer, but the majority will be done next summer.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 2:00 p.m., to go into Executive Session at 2:15 p.m.
