### 13. PUBLIC HEARINGS

- a. SECOND READING AND PUBLIC HEARING/Ordinance No. PA 1053/ In the Matter of Adopting Amendments to the Lane County Rural Comprehensive Plan and the Junction City Comprehensive Plan to Adopt Text Changes to the City Comprehensive Plan Document, Redesignate Lands Within the Junction City Urban Growth Boundary, to Enlarge the Junction City Urban Growth Boundary and to Redesignate and Rezone these Affected Lands, to Adopt an Exception to Statewide Planning Goal 3, to Correct an Error in the Rural Comprehensive Plan's Depiction of the Junction City Urban Growth Boundary on Plot 280 and Rezone Affected Property, to Adopt Savings and Severability Clauses, and Declaring an Emergency.

Rust read this Ordinance into the record. Michael Copely, Associate Planner, reviewed the agenda memorandum, recommending approval.

Rust opened the Public Hearing. There being no one present who wished to testify, Rust closed the Public Hearing. MOTION: Approval of Ordinance PA 1053. Roberts MOVED, Dumdi SECONDED. The secretary polled the Board. VOTE: Cornacchia, Dumdi, Roberts and Rust - all AYES. (4-0).

### 14. OTHER BUSINESS

Bill Van Vactor, County Administrator, indicated that he had received a phone call from Jeff Towery, the City Manager of Cottage Grove, with regard to the possible location of a veterans' hospital in that community. In response to Towery's question, the Board indicated that Lane County has

no interest in pursuing the matter separately and would likely have limited resources to assist in Cottage Grove's efforts to attract the facility.
