Many people do not follow through with their human rights complaints simply because they do not have the support needed. The Human Rights Support System, or HRSS, is a volunteer-based system for assisting community members who have experienced harassment or discrimination. Trained community volunteers assist individuals by offering both technical and emotional support and by providing appropriate and coordinated referral services. The volunteer serves as a facilitator and helps to humanize the process of seeking resolution. The HRSS is a tool to empower people.

The Eugene Human Rights Program, the Lane County Human Rights Advisory Committee and Eugene's 4J School District are seeking volunteers to serve as HRSS advocates.
