- **Beginning WESTLAW**—Learning to use the WESTLAW databases for simple legal research. How to retrieve cases using natural language searches, use cite checking tools, and formulate simple search requests.
- **Advanced WESTLAW**—Learn to use specialized searching tools. Advanced Boolean searching, using field restrictors to focus search results
- **Legal Research on the Internet**—Review of basic legal web sites for federal and state statutes, case law and regulations. Review of blogs, meta-search engines, and portal sites relevant to legal issues. (Basic, for beginners)
- **Hints for Using Fastcase**— A quick overview of the OSB's Fastcase service, with practical tips on how to use some of this system's features.
- **HeinOnline for Law Reviews**—A quick overview of this database, which includes historical law review articles.
- **Federal Legislative History Online**—Using HeinOnline for historical statutes and congressional materials to search for background on federal statutes. .
- **Self-Help Web Sites**—A brief overview of web sites useful to the general public
- **BarBooks**—Learn basic navigational skills for using OSB's BarBooks (CLE Handbooks) service; includes use of Word formatted forms
- **Using Online Shepards**—Introduction to using Shepards Citations online, through LEXIS.
