



## **Public Meeting Announcement Regarding Lane County's 20-Year Coordinated Population Forecast Project**

As required by state law, Lane County is in the process of developing a 20-year coordinated population forecast for the county and each of its urban areas. These forecasts will be long-range estimates of the future population of the county, its cities and rural areas and will be used to determine future city and county needs for housing, jobs, transportation, water and sanitary sewer systems, fire and police stations, and parks. City, county and community service providers such as school districts and hospitals may also rely on these forecasts to plan for future expansions.

Lane County has contracted with the Portland State University - Population Research Center to develop the forecast figures. Preliminary forecast numbers have recently been released by the Population Research Center and are now available for review. The preliminary forecast numbers can be downloaded from the County's population project website at:
