SUSPECT #1: Black male adult, 5'08", medium build, wearing a dark blue "hoodie" with a white symbol on the front, and dark pants.

SUSPECT #2: Hispanic male adult, thin build - (Driver)

SUSPECT VEHICLE: Late 90's dark green Buick or Oldsmobile type car with the rounded body style. Vehicle has an unknown Oregon tree plate.

DETAILS:

On 03-23-10, at approximately 0936 hours, Lane County Sheriff's deputies were dispatched to 29973 Carol Avenue, regarding a robbery that had just occurred. The victim, Jodi Skalos, reported she was home with her child when she observed a dark green Buick or Oldsmobile type vehicle pull into her driveway. Ms. Skalos heard a knock at the door and as she answered the door a black male pushed his way in and demanded money. He was armed with a handgun. Ms. Skalos was able to set off her car alarm, which scared the suspects away. Ms. Skalos received minor injuries during the incident; however, the child was not harmed.
