NATURE OF STORY: Wanted Subject in Felony Elude, Theft II, UUMV, Parole Violation Case Captured

LOCATION: Springfield

DETAILS: Deputies from the Lane County Sheriff's Office captured 37-year-old Robert Dare Holden in Springfield today at approximately 12:30 PM. Deputies followed up many investigative leads and tips from citizens while searching for Holden. The investigation led Deputies to 'A' Street in Springfield where Holden was arrested, along with another wanted subject, Karlton Wayne Day, DOB 01-27-1976. Day had several warrants for his arrest. Holden was the subject of a March 6, 2008 press release seeking the public's assistance in locating him.

On Thursday March 6, 2008, a Deputy made contact with Holden in the Joshua Sand Dunes North of Florence for an off-road violation. During the contact the Deputy determined the motorcycle the subject was riding was stolen. As the Deputy moved towards Holden to apprehend him, he fled on the stolen motorcycle East through the sand dunes. A pursuit was called and the motorcyclist fled through the dunes. Deputies recovered the stolen motorcycle later that day in some brush behind a

residence along Highway 101 near Friendly Acres Road. The investigating Deputy recognized the subject as Holden; the individual who had fled on the motorcycle.

The Lane County Sheriff's Office appreciates all the tips and information provided by Lane County citizens during the course of this investigation.
