NATURE OF STORY: Overdue Mushroom Picker Subject of Search

DETAILS: Involved: Sainsbury, Nolan H. 42 year old male

At 2106 hours on 4/4/11, the Lane County Sheriff's Office received a call regarding an overdue mushroom picker who was last seen on Forest Service lands near Adams Mountain off Brice Creek Road.

The 42 year old male was last seen at 3:30PM by two of his friends when he entered the woods. Search crews combed the Cedar Creek drainage during the night and into Tuesday, 4/5/11. At 1000 hours the subject was located on a road system several miles away from the ground search area. He spent the night out with minimum clothing and no fire. He had mild hypothermia and was treated by medical personnel, then released to his family.

Mr. Sainsbury carried no survival equipment. It is recommended that, when recreating in our forests, a person carry survival equipment that's appropriate for the season and your skill level.
