DETAILS: On May 27, 2009 Lane County Sheriff's Search and Rescue was notified by the Springfield Police Department of their case involving a missing person who was last seen in the Dorena area of South Lane County while visiting a family member. The missing person was identified as Thomas S. Davis who was described as a white male, 5 ft 9 inches tall and weighing approximately 250 to 300 pounds.

Davis is further described as having brown hair and blue eyes. Davis was last seen wearing blue jeans, a blue colored "Spiderman" t-shirt, a light weight jacket and has a small black back-pack. Davis also wears a camouflaged baseball cap that has an eagle over an American flag patch on the front. Davis possibly suffers from some physical and mental health issues including diabetes.

Davis has been known to go camping in the wilderness areas surrounding the community of Dorena and also frequents the Whitaker Neighborhood of Eugene. If Davis is seen or contacted, please advise the Springfield Police Department or the Lane County Sheriff's Office.
