DETAILS: Deputies from the Lane County Sheriff's Office responded to a residential burglary on Schnorenberg Lane at approximately 1:56 p.m. An area resident advised the upstairs of her home was broken into while she was in the residence.

She fled her residence but provided a license plate number and a vehicle description to responding Deputies without placing herself in harms way. A short time later the South Lane Resident Deputy located the involved vehicle, a 1994 Cadillac Seville, Oregon plate number 449 DHP, white in color traveling South on Territorial Highway near Hamm Road. The vehicle's license plate matched the plate number given by the complainant on Schnorenberg.

Additional Deputies responded to the area and a traffic stop was conducted on the involved vehicle. Deputies arrested the driver and lone suspect in the involved burglary, Ozzie Davis. Deputies recovered property stolen from the Schnorenberg residence that included a Mac Book computer and several pieces of jewelry.

While Deputies were investigating this case, additional burglary calls came in from Bailey Hill Road and Territorial Highway. Deputies responded to the other involved residences. Investigation revealed property from both of the involved residences to be in Davis's possession.

All three residences had been forcibly entered. Stolen property from the involved residences was identified by the property owners and returned to them. Davis was taken into custody and lodged at the Lane County Jail on 3 counts of Burglary I, 3 counts of Theft I, 2 counts of Criminal Mischief II and 1 count of Criminal Mischief I.
