The Lane County Sheriff's Office reminds all motorists that the ordinances and laws related to illegal parking will be enforced throughout Lane County.

Activity on some social networking sites indicates that a large number of people may be planning on attending a music festival in the Blachly area this weekend. The festival is currently under scrutiny from Lane County authorities because event organizers have failed to obtain the proper permits or adequately plan for public safety.

County officials are seeking a court order to halt the festival later today, but in the meantime all laws and regulations related to illegal parking will be enforced. Vehicles parked on private property without the permission of the property owner may be towed, and vehicles parked on any public roadway that constitute a hazard will be towed. Any vehicle illegally parked is subject to a citation and fine.
