) HORSE CREEK BRIDGE ON DELTA ROAD

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved participation in the rehabilitation or reconstruction of the West Fork Horse Creek bridge on Delta Road and subsequent acceptance into the county road system through Board Orders 00-1-19-6 and 00-2-23-3; and

WHEREAS, the bridge consultant hired to evaluate the West Fork Horse Creek bridge has recommended a lower weight limit posting for the bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has directed county staff under his authority in Lane Code 15.215 to post the bridge for the recommended weight limits of 15 tons (Type 3 truck), 19 tons (Type 3S2 truck), and 18 tons (Type 3-3 truck) in order to protect public safety and prevent damage to the bridge; and


