) SYSTEM (SAVNS)

WHEREAS, state Department of Corrections and the Oregon Department of Justice have entered into a grant award agreement to coordinate their efforts to grant financial and other assistance in support of a project that will further the goals of providing services to victims of violent crime; and

WHEREAS, these government agencies, together with a broad-based steering committee, have identified as an important goal the development of a statewide 24-hour automated victim notification system (SAVNS) that will give victims of violent crime access to and notification about critical information concerning the criminal justice process and events related to his/her criminal offender; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, along with the sheriff and the community corrections manager desire to participate in SAVNS; and

WHEREAS, known costs associated with the implementation of SAVNS has already been budgeted through the AIRS conversion project; and

WHEREAS, the state Department of Corrections has forwarded an intergovernmental agreement #2548 which allows for Lane County to participate in SAVNS; and

WHEREAS, the term of the IGA #2548 is co-terminus with the six-year SAVNS service agreement with Appriss, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the intergovernmental agreement resulting from the above requires signature authority to be delegated to the county administrator per Lane Manual 21.145;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate signature authority to the county administrator to sign an intergovernmental agreement #2548 with the State of Oregon to allow Lane County to participate in the statewide automated victim notification system (SAVNS.)
