
**WHEREAS**, there is sufficient funds in the grant; and

**RESOLVED AND ORDERED**, that the budget of the Workforce Partnership Department (37) be adjusted to reflect an increase in revenues by \$250,000; and increase in staff two employment specialists, one community service worker and .5 FTE accounting clerk positions for the exclusive use of the Lane Workforce Partnership Department (37), fund (249).
