WHEREAS, substance use among youth in Lane County is a serious and growing problem; and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Prevention Coalition has worked with the larger community to develop a plan to decrease substance abuse in the county; and

WHEREAS, federal funding is available to fund the project; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services is prepared to develop and submit the year five continuation proposal for the Drug-Free Communities Support Program in response the Federal Request for papers.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners grant authority to the County Administrator to sign and authorize a grant application to the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in the amount of \$74,663, and all subsequent continuation applications.
