WHEREAS, ORS 423.539 establishes Public Safety Coordinating Councils and mandates minimum membership to engage in coordinated public safety and justice planning;


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is charged with ratifying appointments to the PSCC when vacancies occur;


