WHEREAS, Melissa Galloway, an 18-year-old student of Elmira High School, received semifinalist status in the Intel Science Talent Search for high school seniors; and


WHEREAS, the Lane County Board of Commissioners wishes to acknowledge the commendable achievements young citizens are making in their schools and in their communities; and
