WHEREAS, firearm-related crime is of significant national and local concern,

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has awarded a grant for \$240,000 to Lane County to improve the long-term ability of the County to address firearm-related violence, and to deter firearm-related violent crime through the swift certainty of prosecution, and

WHEREAS, no funds will be expended under this grant until there is a further review of the fiscal implications through the ordinary budget process,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Lane County accepts a U.S. Department of Justice Grant for \$240,000; and
2. The County Administrator is delegated authority to execute grant documents.
