WHEREAS, the medical examiner function at the state level was moved from the State Health Division to the Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, the role of the medical examiner is viewed as more of a forensic function than a health function, which has led to a statewide trend to move the medical examiner function to the District Attorney's Office; and


WHEREAS, the funding for the remaining months of FY 2001/2002 is estimated at \$35,619 and would be handled as a transfer from Health & Human Services to the District Attorney's Office; and

WHEREAS, the funding for FY 02/03 will be \$184,389. \$78,032 will come directly from the General Fund and \$106,357 will be a transfer from Health & Human Services to the District Attorney's office; and


WHEREAS, Health & Human Services has agreed to pay salary cost of living adjustments, adjusted indirect and Information Services charges, and other materials & services related to the 1.0 FTE Deputy Medical Examiner position for a period of five years or through FY 06/07.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners transfers the 1.0 FTE Deputy Medical Examiner Position #15711 from Fund 286 Health & Human Services to Fund 124 District Attorney effective April 13, 2002 and to increase FY 01/02 revenue and expense appropriations in Fund 124 by \$35,619.
