)IN THE MATTER OF A
)DECLARATION OF HOUSING
)AUTHORITY POWERS

WHEREAS, ORS 456.095 provides that the County governing body may elect to have the powers of a housing authority to be exercised in a number of ways, and

WHEREAS, since 1979, the Lane County Board of Commissioners, as a result of such an election, has exercised those powers itself, and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature has amended the laws governing housing authorities (2001 OR Laws Ch. 547) to provide at least one, but not more than two, housing authority positions be filled by residents, pursuant to the Quality Housing and Work Responsibility Act of 1998 (P.L. 105-276) and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of Lane County for it to continue to exercise the powers of the housing authority itself, with the addition of a housing authority commissioner who is a resident who receives direct assistance from the Housing Authority


NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to ORS 456.095, the Board of County Commissioners hereby declares that the practice of having the governing body of Lane County itself exercise the powers of a housing authority under ORS Ch. 455 and 446.515-446.547 shall continue, and it is further

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners shall regularly appoint one additional person to serve as a non-elected commissioner of the Housing Authority and Community Services Agency (HACSA) of Lane County, along with the elected Lane County Board of Commissioners, said appointed non-elected HACSA commissioner to be a resident who receives direct assistance from HACSA.
