WHEREAS, Lane County's Tourism Marketing plan provides for the selection of special projects to complement and enhance the plan, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the McKenzie Valley is important to Lane County's overall economy, and


WHEREAS, McKenzie River businesses have been negatively impacted by the muddy flows in the McKenzie River resulting from the Cougar Dam project and

WHEREAS, the McKenzie Chamber of Commerce has dedicated funds to provide additional tourism marketing of the McKenzie River area.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the expenditure of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) from Tourism Special Project funds to match the funds provided by the McKenzie Chamber of Commerce for the purpose of marketing the McKenzie River area for tourism, and it is further


ORDERED, that the County Administrator is authorized to sign the necessary contract documents.
