The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County orders as follows:

THIS MATTER having come before the Board of County Commissioners for the acceptance of Central Lane County Interagency Narcotics Enforcement Team (INET) intergovernmental agreement.

WHEREAS, Lane County has a long standing interest in reducing the impact of criminal drug activities on the people of Lane County; and

WHEREAS, Lane County, through the Department of Public Safety - Lane County Sheriff's Office, detects, apprehends, prosecutes and incarcerates the perpetrators of criminal drug enterprises in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, Lane County actively seeks to prevent and treat drug abuse associated with illicit trade in narcotics; and


WHEREAS, Lane County recognizes the effectiveness of combined efforts of public safety and law enforcement agencies to jointly act to interdict illegal drug-related activities;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners approves the intergovernmental INET agreement and delegates authority to the County Administrator to execute the intergovernmental agreement as appropriate, in substantial conformity with the attached Exhibit "A".
