WHEREAS, the erosion of the McKenzie River bank resulted in severe undercutting of the home, resulting in the potential of falling into the McKenzie River, and

WHEREAS, the Mathews home was demolished to prevent it from falling into the McKenzie River, with resulting risk of attendant environmental damage and potential contamination of the drinking water supply used by EWEB, and


WHEREAS, funds are currently available within the Operational Contingency account within General Expense; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, as per ORS 294.450(1), has authority to transfer appropriations within a fund from one organizational unit to another;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that \$3,000 be transferred within the General fund from the Operational Contingency Fund to Materials and Services, to pay for a portion of the debris removal associated with the demolition of the Mathews home.
